

Rules for 2009 Heart of America Gelbvieh Association “Show-Me” Futurity Plus Sale

1. A \$100.00 per lot nomination fee must accompany entry form before cattle will be cataloged. This nomination fee applies toward the sale expense of all cattle and is non-refundable. Any cattle that are pulled out of the sale after catalog is printed, forfeit this entry fee, unless substituted with another sellable lot. All “no-sales” will pay full commission on the final sale bid. The sale is to be self-supporting with all fixed expenses and commissions to be prorated on a percentage basis. A 1% commission will be charged by HAGA just as in previous association sponsored sales. Each consignor will receive a net check as soon as all monies have been collected from buyers.
2. All registered females must furnish current American Gelbvieh Association Registration Certificates so they can be transferred to the new owners. All animals must be properly tattooed and may be inspected at the sale site. All certificates must be submitted to sale management before cattle will be allowed to sell.
3. Fullblood, Purebred, Balancer and Gelbvieh influenced females will be allowed to sell in the 2009 sale.
4. All consignors must be members of the HAGA. A \$35.00 membership fee will be deducted from the sale proceeds of any non-member.
5. Females have the option of being halter broken or non-haltered unless designated as “Futurity Heifers.”
6. Females must be born after January 1, 2003.
7. All females selling bred must be pregnancy examined by a licensed veterinarian with said status listed on the individual health certificate. Open females will be guaranteed to breed.
8. Any female used as a donor in an embryo transfer program must be designated as such. If a female is a current transfer recipient, information on the embryo must be furnished including an embryo transfer certificate.
9. Futurity Heifers must be purebred (88% or greater) and born between September 1, 2008 and August 31, 2009.
10. A fee of \$35.00 per Futurity Heifer will be held out of proceeds to be added to the premium purse.
11. All Futurity Heifers must be halter broken.
12. Any animal that arrives at the sale site in an unsound or undesirable condition will be rejected by the sale committee and/or the sale management. Also, any animal that exhibits an adverse or unruly disposition may be rejected by the sale committee and/or sale management.
13. All registered cattle must be clipped and cleaned to be sold in the 2009 HAGA Female Sale. A clipping service will be available at the sale facility to help those who do not have the ability to have this done prior to the sale date. An additional fee will be charged for this service and deducted from your sale proceeds. Sale management must be notified prior to arrival if you require this assistance.
